# **MOOO RECIPES**



Panko crumbs. mixed with the cheese and butter. make the crust perfectly crunchy. Cod or any other type of white fish work well. Make it with Dubliner Cheese for a more traditional taste.

### Irish Fish with Cream

4 cod or white fish filets 2 Tbsp fresh parsley, minced seasoning salt 1/2 c fine Panko crumbs 2 Tbsp Country Cream butter. melted

2 tsp strong Irish mustard 2 tsp minced green onions

6 oz Tillamook sharp cheddar cheese, shredded 11/2 c Longmont Dairy whipping cream

Preheat the oven to 375° F. Butter a casserole dish and set aside. Sprinkle fish with seasoning salt.

Combine bread crumbs, butter, mustard, onions, and parsley in a bowl. Add cheese and mix well. Pat mixture on top of filets to form crust.

Pour cream over and around fish. Bake until fish is cooked through and crust is golden brown, about 20 minutes. Serve immediately.
